It also includes 44 hours of cultural events as excursions in Tomsk, visits to the Museum of History of Tomsk, temples and theaters; trips to the historical fortress; excursion to industrial enterprises producing local branded products; participation in master classes which consist in painting clay and wooden toys; visit to the international festival called "the Day of the Ax competition".

Starting date: the 12th of August 2019/ Ending date: the 29th of August 2019

Deadline - The usual deadline for applying to our Summer School is 2 months before the starting date.

Accomodation

The University offers rooms in a modern dormitory "Parus", which is 5 minutes away on foot from the University (\$16 for the whole period).
